

## HOLIDAYS

There is no bus service and the GMTA offices are closed on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Holiday schedule does not include specific seasonal services, which are scheduled to operate on these days. ## BIKES ON THE BUS

Most GMTA Franklin/Grand Isle buses are equipped with easy-to-use bike racks. There is no extra charge for using the bike racks. You must load/unload your own bike. Bike racks hold a maximum of two bikes, including children's bikes. To verify that the bus you will be taking is equipped with a bike rack, please call 802-527-2181 one working day in advance. Bike racks are available on a first come, first served basis. Folding bikes are allowed inside the bus provided they can be kept out of the aisle or under the seat. Control of the folding bike must be maintained at all times. Drivers may limit the number of folding bikes allowed on board depending on bus capacity.

## ADA SERVICE

All GMTA buses are equipped with wheelchair lifts and wheelchair tie-down spaces. Complimentary paratransit requirements are met through provided service deviations.

## ROUTE DEVIATIONS

Some GMTA routes will travel off their fixed route on request. Passengers are asked to call 527-2181 to request a deviation. Requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance and may be scheduled up to one month in advance. Deviations are on a first come, first serve basis as each deviation route schedule permits. There is no charge for deviations. For a complete deviation policy, please call 527-2181.

## REQUEST STOPS

Bus will pick up or drop off at specified location on route by request. To schedule a pick up request, passengers must call GMTA at least 24 hours in advance, unless otherwise noted on route schedule. Request service can be called in weekly. To cancel a request pick up service without penalty, passengers must contact GMTA no later than one (1) hour before the scheduled pick-up time. For a request drop off, passengers may request their stop when boarding the bus.

STEP 1: FOLD ALONG LINE

If a customer schedules a route deviation or request stop and cannot make a scheduled trip, s/he should make every effort to cancel the scheduled trip and later than one (1) hour before the scheduled pick-up time. Customers may incur penalties for repeated cancellations, cancellations called in less than one hour before the scheduled pick up and No-Shows. ### CANCELLATION/NO-SHOWS

Plan to get to the bus stop five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Due to traffic, please keep in mind that the bus may arrive a few minutes past its scheduled arrival. Buses may also be flagged down on the route and will stop in a safe and accessible location.
