

Break in the Ice: Bus to Return One Day a Week

New funding has been obtained for a shuttle bus which can be used by everyone.

The bus will run on Wednesdays with specific pick up locations around the village and will run from 9:40 a.m. until 1:15 p.m. If time permits, the bus will also pick up people in Roxbury.

Direct service will be to the Grand Union, the food shelf, the food stamp outpost, the pharmacy for health care needs and any other local services which may be needed by riders.

Charles Morse, member of the Select Board, stated that “though the times of operation are somewhat limited, I believe with collaborative efforts, we can meet the needs of many transit dependent residents within the area.”

He went on to state that the actual routes are currently under consideration. A meeting was held at the Senior Center last Monday to get input from residents about setting the routes. Based upon the input received, the actual routes will be developed.
